

**-Builder Topics Discussed:**

-When is CityView going live: Naples anticipates going live with small projects beginning in mid-December. It is anticipated that new residential and commercial will go live in January. Craig requested that Kathy Curatolo send names of those members who participated in the initial Pilot Project Task Force and would like to participate in testing (List was sent 110918)

-Will Port Royal be part of the CityView system? It is anticipated that Port Royal will participate in CityView. Cost has been shared and the City is waiting to hear back.

-Can sub- contractors be changed after a project has been started. Yes, via an email request to City Permitting.

-It appears there were 2 or 3 new inspections added. See attached listing of all City of Naples inspections with those that are new highlighted in red. They are #s 165 window /door attachment, 401 concrete encased electrode, and 455 permanent power final.

-If contractor is working on an electronic permit and cannot complete the application in one sitting, will the work that has been done be able to be saved? Yes the partially completed application can be saved for later enabling you to go back and complete at a later time.

**Building Official Topics Discussed:**

1. Craig Mole noted that contractors no longer will need to register with the City of Naples. They will be asked to simply list sub-contractors and design professionals in the system with application. Contractors will register with the County for Naples.
2. Currently the CSI program covers residential beginning at 5500 feet under air. The City will probably be going to 7500 feet under air to qualify for the program after January 1, 2019.
