Reason CBIA chose this project:

Matilde Ramirez is wheelchair bound and suffers from Parkinson's disease. This past year, Mr. Ramirez had a heart attack.

Their home has three exits with stairs to enter/exit. This construction project was chosen because this is a life safety issue for Mr. and Mrs. Ramirez. No entrance/exit at their home is currently wheel chair accessible.

Request for work was made by Sara Guitierrez, Case Manager, Collier County Housing, Human and Veteran Services.

Scope of Work:

Remove existing front entry porch and stairs. Construction crews will rebuild porch and railing; repair and waterproof siding; add a ramp for wheelchair accessibility; add a concrete pad/stoop at bottom of ramp, add paver walkway from ramp to driveway, incorporate sod around ramp and paver walkway, add replace gutters at front entrance, replace lighting at front door entrance. The newly designed and constructed ramp will provide for easy access to load/unload wheelchair from a vehicle.
